Topics in *IJR* include the use of responsibility in academic and nonacademic settings; structural and ideological dimensions affecting the development of new perspectives on the topic of responsibility; the ethics of research, teaching, and practice of responsibility; the application of a focus on responsibility in practical problems; the historical and interdisciplinary roots of responsibility; and the contributions of a focus on responsibility for interpersonal, policy and public issues.

The journal accepts submissions on the full range of topics related to responsibility as well as special editions dedicated to one topic. Manuscript submission guidelines for authors appear on the final page of each issue.
