- **Increase visibility** through Google Scholar and major search engines.
- **Increase accessibility** through unique, persistent URLs... no more “dead links” on other web sites.
- **Central location for all of your scholarship** – both published and unpublished, as a compliment to existing print and electronic publications. Supplemental content can be uploaded to provide additional information and context.
- **Create reports** to indicate timely impact of your work, including views, downloads, and how your work was discovered.
- **Publicize** your work through mailing lists, social media, and RSS feeds.
