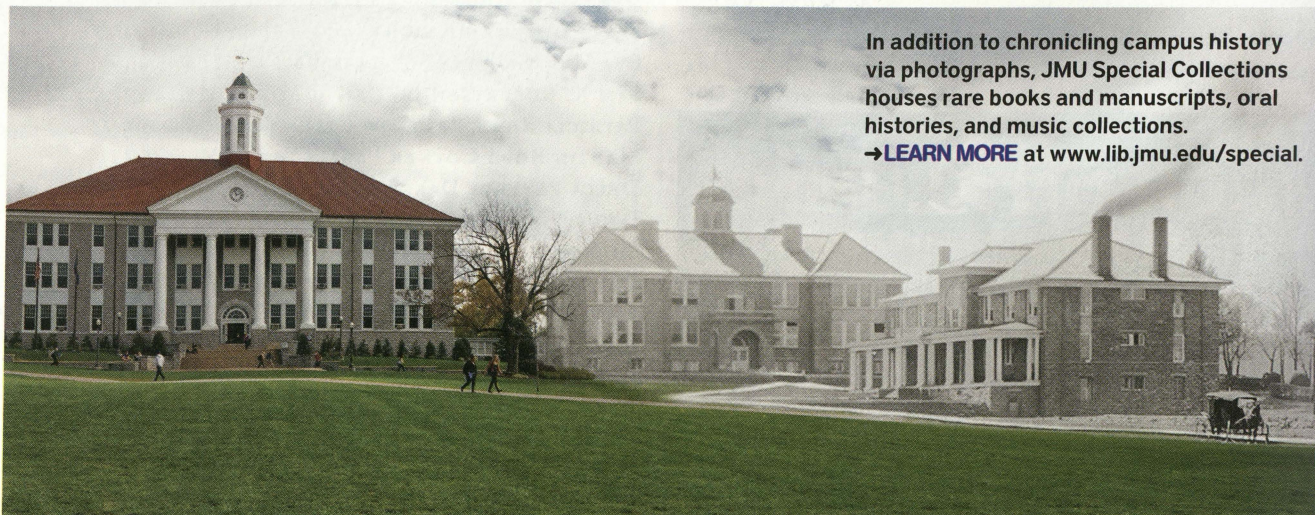


Walking through time
