The investigation team concluded that the contributing factor to this accident was Carelessness of deminer in terms of use of bayonet by left hand which was in contrary to his habit.

Analysis

The primary cause of this accident is listed as Victim inattention because the investigators determined that the Victim used his left hand to excavate when unaccustomed to doing so and so made an error. The Victim may have swapped hands because of the inappropriate nature of the bayonet used to excavate in hard ground. The secondary cause is listed as Inadequate equipment because the handtool did not meet the IMAS recommendations for blast resistant tools.

The “Inadequate investigation” listed under notes refers to the absence of a full accident report. The UN supported MACCA has failed to make these widely available for some years in contravention of the requirements of the IMAS. The failure of the UN to share the Afghan investigators’ work with others is regrettable.
